### **INVITATION**

1. Our view of the future, affects how we live today. What is your view of the future?

### **RECOLLECTION**

2. What stood out to you as you listened to the sermon Sunday morning? Was there anything said on which you require further clarity?

Are there areas in which you would like to see change in your own walk with the Lord? How can your Grace Group hold you accountable?

### **OBSERVATION**

3. In the context of this text, what is “the error of lawless people” that leads to instability? Practically, how do we avoid this error and thereby maintain our stability?

### **APPLICATION**

4. Theologians sometimes talk of living in an already / not yet state? What does it mean to live in an already / not yet state? Discuss the practicalities of this theology.

5. We live in hope of the resurrection. Flesh this statement out in terms of how we live today in light of tomorrow.
  
6. Romans 8:22–25 gives us the assurance that a better day is coming. Discuss and consider this portion of Scripture.
  
7. What opportunity is there for us as we experience the Lord’s patience of the Lord? Specifically, what opportunity is there for us in terms of salvation and the pursuit of holiness?
