INVITATION

RECOLLECTION

2. What stood out to you as you listened to the sermon Sunday morning? Was there anything said on which you require further clarity?

Are there areas in which you would like to see change in your own walk with the Lord? How can your Grace Group hold you accountable?

OBSERVATION

3. Talk about Paul’s use of the word “gift” to describe singleness and marriage (v. 7). What does he mean that marital statuses are a “gift”? In what way? How should we use these gifts?

APPLICATION

4. Did God design sex for recreation or procreation? Explain.

5. What does singleness look like in the church? How does this work out in the church body? Can we do a better job of ministering to singles in the church?

6. Christians are called to live with self-control. Are you able to identify areas of your life in which you can improve in self-control?

Why is it important for us to learn self-control, and to teach our children self-control, as a means to guarding sexual purity?

7. When, how and who ought parents to speak to their children about sexual activity and morality?
