INVITATION

1. What heritage do you come from?

RECOLLECTION

OBSERVATION

3. Paul doesn't start with doctrine but by drawing attention to relationships. Why do you think he took this approach?

APPLICATION

4. Some people think of spiritual gifts like a microwave dinner: ready-made. Paul spoke as if one can grow and develop a spiritual gift.

Practically how can we identify our spiritual gifting, and how can we fan that deposit into flame?

What, in our Christian walk, might be extinguishing this deposit rather than flaming it?

How can God use us to fan in to flame the deposit of the gospel that God has placed in each other?

5. In which areas in life can you take more risk to advance the kingdom?

6. What should a Christian's attitude toward death be?

7. What about the gospel might we be tempted to be ashamed of?

Who guards the gospel ministry? What does that look like?
