INVITATION

1. What kind of idols are present in our congregation that we might be oblivious to? How practically can we run away from sin associated with such idols?

RECOLLECTION

2. What stood out to you as you listened to the sermon Sunday morning? Was there anything said on which you require further clarity?

Are there areas in which you would like to see change in your own walk with the Lord? How can your Grace Group hold you accountable?

OBSERVATION

3. What is the significance of Paul telling us to “judge for ourselves” (v. 15)? After all, what does thinking have to do with faith?

APPLICATION

4. What might we miss by completely disregarding “the unseen realm” of the Bible? How might we be guilty of “participating with demons” in our day-and-age?

5. What is the difference between pharisaic legalism and wise avoidance of behaviours, situations, and activities that might lead to temptation?

6. In what ways do we live with one foot in the church and one in the world? What keeps us in this position?

7. If the gospel is all about free and full forgiveness in Christ, why should we be so concerned about sin? To err is human after all. Surely God's grace is sufficient to cover our imperfections?

Do we really need to fear falling away from Christ?
