to the corners of the earth that Christ has come.

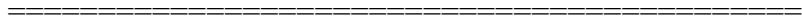
*Let the nations be glad, let the peoples rejoice, for salvation belongs to our God.

for salvation belongs to our God. Let the nations be glad.*

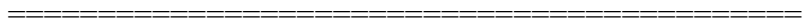


**LEAD ME TO THE CROSS**
