RECOLLECTION

1. What stood out to you as you listened to the sermon Sunday morning? Was there anything said on which you require further clarity?

Are there areas in which you would like to see change in your own walk with the Lord? How can your Grace Group hold you accountable?

OBSERVATION

2. What general topic/theme is Paul addressing in chapter 12 and how does it connect with chapter 11?
3. What does Paul mean by saying that he doesn't want the Corinthians to be “uninformed”? (v. 1) Of what were they ignorant such that Paul needed to address them the way he did?
4. What does Paul mean by saying that “no one can say ‘Jesus is Lord’ except in the Holy Spirit” (v. 3)?

Similarly, what does Paul mean by saying that “no one speaking in the Spirit of God ever says ‘Jesus is accursed!’”?

5. What is the significance of Paul's trinitarian principle in vv. 4–6? How is trinitarian theology practical?

APPLICATION

6. In your experience, what have been the marks of a truly spiritual person?
7. What is mindless/ignorant worship? Is this only something that other churches can get wrong?
8. What does one mean by the phrase, "Jesus is Lord of all or not Lord at all"? How does it look to live out this truth?
9. What is the role of the Holy Spirit in our worship, both personally and corporately?
10. Discuss the meaning and significance of the phrase, "Spiritual experiences are not self-
11. What lies behind the desire to boast about one's spiritual gifts? What makes this especially out of sync with Paul's writing?

12. Write down some prayer requests mentioned in your Group and pray for them throughout this week.
