### **RECOLLECTION**

1. What stood out to you as you listened to the sermon on Sunday morning? Was there anything said on which you require further clarity?

### **OBSERVATION**

2. How is God revealed in vv. 1–6?
3. What distinction does the psalmist make between the kind of revelation described in vv. 1–6 and vv. 7–11? Why is it important for us to understand this distinction?
4. List the words the psalmist uses to describe the law of the Lord. What single point is he trying to get across by describing the law of God in this way?
5. According to vv. 12–14, what is a biblical response to God’s revelation of himself?

What is the connection between God’s revelation and our repentance?

### **APPLICATION**

6. Are you an outdoors kind of person? What is it about the outdoors that draws you?
7. What is so significant about the truth that our God is a revealing God?

What would we lack if he were not so?

Why does he reveal himself?

8. What keeps us from desiring the word of God more than "gold" and "honey" (v. 10)?

How can we cultivate a delight in Scripture?

9. "The law of God sets us free." Discuss how this can be true in light of Psalm 19.

Considering how many imperatives there are throughout the Bible, how can the law be freeing?

10. "The law of God sets us free." Discuss how this can be true in light of Psalm 19. How can our modern notions of individual needs get in the way of worship?

What are acceptable thoughts and meditations?

11. Considering vv. 12–13, how do you deal with the doctrine of God's wrath/anger against sin?

How should we understand God's love in a way that doesn't conflict with his judgement?
