RECOLLECTION

1. What stood out to you as you listened to the sermon on Sunday morning? Was there anything said on which you require further clarity?

OBSERVATION

2. Why does Paul use the language of getting dressed throughout the passage (vv. 53–54)?
3. Why will the saying “Death is swallowed up in victory” only come to pass at the resurrection? Why didn’t it come to pass at Christ’s resurrection?
4. What does it mean that the sting of death is sin?
5. Have you ever had a near death experience? How did you feel at the time?

APPLICATION

6. Did Jesus conquer death on the cross, or does death remain as an enemy yet to be conquered?
7. How does God give the victory in the present (v. 56)?

8. How should we deal with death as believers? How can we help one another in this regard?
9. We should take risks for the sake of the gospel. How do we evaluate risks encountered in service to Christ as those risks relate to others? Could it ever be right to “risk the lives” of your kids and fellow church members?
10. Why is our work and labour not in vain? Is only “Christian work” not in vain?
11. BBC, we need to live with resurrection conviction and confidence. Too many members are not, evidenced by petty grudges, puny excuses, passive-resistance, prayerless living, passionless worship, prideful non-involvement, and, for some, poor attendance. What will make the difference?
