### **RECOLLECTION**

### **OBSERVATION**

2. Have you ever experienced your spirit being disturbed / not at rest in your Christian walk? What was the cause?
3. How should we think about opportunities and the will of God? Should a sense of peace be considered?
4. What are the three ingredients that Paul gives of a gospel fragrance?  
  
How do we minister accordingly?
5. Why does Paul speak about salvation in the present-continuous tense?

### **APPLICATION**

6. How could Paul be speaking about the triumph of Christ when he was facing such discouragement?
7. How can a minister of the gospel remain joyfully triumphant when his message of life and hope is received as the stench of death?  
  
In what ways can the congregation help the ministers not be troubled?
8. How is it that the same message of the gospel can produce such differing responses in those who hear?
9. The temptation when we recognise that the gospel message is the stench of death to some is to water-down the gospel message. What are some ways in which we at BBC might be tempted to begin to do just that?
10. How could God be pleased with our ministry of the gospel even if the response from our hearers is rejection?
11. “Who is sufficient for these things?” On what basis did Paul (and do we) continue to minister the gospel?
